- Examine the processes that successful policy making should follow, including key elements such as issue analysis, policy options, the budget process, consultation and co-ordination

COURSE FEATURES

CORE PROGRAM

The core program is designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills to make a major contribution to policy development and policy leadership. Senior public sector leaders from across a variety of portfolio areas share their experiences and perspectives.

ALUMNIST IN RESIDENCE

How often do you hear 'If only I had known...' Past IPAA Gain the Policy Edge participants join the course to support peer learning and to share their knowledge.

SIMULATED POLICY PROCESS

Participants work in syndicate groups to prepare a hypothetical policy presentation to government. It concludes with a simulation in Parliament House where participants practice and receive feedback on their policy formulations and presentations from former Ministers and Secretaries.

NETWORKS ACROSS GOVERNMENT

The program provides opportunities for participants to network, engage and debate with each other. Participants form strong bonds across government which endure throughout their careers.
